## NOTES

The **Ordinary Membership** criteria are:

1. Persons whose main residence is in the Parish of Abernethy or an adjacent parish.
2. All owners of property in the Parish of Abernethy with eligibility extended to their partners, children and grandchildren.
3. At the discretion of the Committee, persons taking up employment of a permanent nature in the Parish of Abernethy.

Voting rights are reserved for Ordinary members.

**Country Membership** is for anyone who does not qualify for Ordinary Membership based on the criteria above. All categories of Country membership enjoy full playing rights including the right to enter competitions.

**Youth Membership** applies to persons who are aged 18 or over but under 21 on the 1st of January.

**Junior Membership** applies to persons under the age of 18 on the 1<sup>st</sup> January.

A Junior Member is entitled to play on the course without adult supervision. If you allow your child to use the course unsupervised, please ensure that they are aware of the hazards that are a greater risk to children than to adults. Hazards identified are the pond at the second tee (nobody should go in the water), crossing the road between the second tee and the second green (ensure your child knows the Green Cross code), and the car park (there are cars moving in situations where the driver may be unaware of small children, make your child aware of moving cars).

Discounted subscription rates (by age categories as shown on our website) will be applied when a subscription is due.

**Membership approval takes approximately two weeks. If you pay on application you are granted playing rights over the course while awaiting membership approval. Our preferred method is by bank transfer quoting your surname as reference (details available at the Club House or from [membership@abernethygolfclub.com](mailto:membership@abernethygolfclub.com)).
