



Coronavirus Guidance – 26 April 2021

Our current Coronavirus Guidance is outlined below.

Currently Scotland is now in Level 3 and travel outside of local areas is permitted. There are no restrictions on the household mix of players in playing groups.

We are not insisting on pre-booking, but we **MUST** keep a record for track and trace of those who have played. Please follow the signing in instructions at the Clubhouse.

If you wish to pre-book (currently only for 9 holes), you can do so online or download the Scottish Golf app (<https://scottishgolf.org/scottish-golf-app/>). Online bookings have priority when teeing off. Even if you pre-book you should still sign in when you arrive.

The clubhouse including changing rooms remains closed. We are therefore unable to offer catering, hire trolleys or clubs. However the outside toilet is open. Please follow good hygiene procedures - hand sanitiser is available. Please leave the toilet as you would wish to find it.

Please observe social distancing at all times.

All shared equipment has been removed. There are no bins. Please take your rubbish home.

All gates are open. Please leave them that way. Leave the course by the gate on the left into the car park.
